We would like to invite you to participate in the 2008 Dublin Laurens St. Patrick's Festival's Arts and Crafts Show and Sale on Saturday and Sunday, March 15th and 16th at Stubbs Park in Dublin, Georgia. The park is dirt and grass.

This is the 43rd year of the Festival, which runs roughly three weeks. The Arts and Crafts Show is in its 33rd year. Our attendance is around 10,000 for this event. There are approximately 150 vendor spaces for rent. The public park used for this event is enclosed with a temporary fence to control the crowds and we charge a \$3.00 admission fee with six years old and under admitted free.

There will be 3 zones: Arts and Crafts, Food, and Lucky's Kiddie Land. On your registration, please specify which zone best suits your needs for consideration.

The St. Patrick's Arts and Crafts Show is a juried arts and crafts event. The chairmen and committee reserve the right to ask vendors to remove items not cleared by the jury panel and listed on the jury application.

If you wish to enter, please complete the attached jury application, return along with your check and a minimum of three pictures or slides displaying the arts you wish to sell before February 15, 2008. Upon receiving your completed jury application, you will be sent the decision of the jury committee, including your zoned area. If rejected, your check will be mailed back to you.

GUIDELINES FOR ST. PATRICK'S ARTS AND CRAFTS
DUBLIN, GEORGIA

All vendors must display and sell their merchandise, either that they themselves create and/or hand decorate OR if accepted by the jury committee, that they resale (Retail Merchandise).

All items need to be clearly marked with artist responsible for the creation and price accordingly.

All artists and craftsman are responsible for setting up and maintaining their own display booth (15' frontage X 15' depth). Please do not extend into another craftsmen's allotted space or out in the area where people walk.

All booths must be set up by time of show's opening at 9 a.m. Saturday morning. Vehicles must be out of the show area by 8 a.m. No vehicles will be allowed in show area to load on Saturday or Sunday until 6 p.m. closing time without special permission.

All participates are asked to be considerate of other vendors.

All paid booths are eligible for Best Display of Wares and Best Irish Theme.

1 st Place	Ribbon and \$60.00
2 nd Place	Ribbon and \$30.00
3 rd Place	Ribbon and \$15.00
Honorable Mention	Ribbon

NON PROFIT ORGANIZATION / INFORMATION

Five booths are available for dissemination of information to local nonprofit organizations. These are assigned on a first come first serve basis. **BOOTHS IN THIS DIVISION ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR PRIZES.**

All food vendors must be cleared with the Arts and Crafts Committee prior to applying for space.
